 - o Mission Broadband (Mike and Lee are the point people
 - Sarah- How long is the partnership is expected to last?
 - One year contract with two automatic renewals and the ability for any party to discontinue the contract with 60 day notice.
 The are acting as ongoing administrative support
 - Jim- will they have representation in the board meetings?
 - We can ask them to participate
 - Evan- we plan to invite them to the next meeting.
 - Woody- do we have a lawyer looking over the contracts and MOUs?
 - Christa- I wrote the MOU and have been providing the redlines for the contracts.
 - NRTC
 - Ray- They bring in experience from a variety of deployments.
 - The CUD is already familiar with some of their work.
 - Waitsfield Telecom (WCVT)
 - Rudy- We gained a lot of confidence in speaking with them and seeing how they run their operation. The experience was genuine and they had their act together. Fred sat down in their conference room with their manager and asked her a list of questions. Was impressed with the tools and apps that they had at their disposal.
 - Mike- wholesale type contracts, revenue streams examples?
 - Christa- referring to the ability to offer wholesale lit services to other ISPs. Solution to RDOF winners in our area. Direct hospital to hospital connection. Cellular/ Small cell Backhaul facilitation.
 - Sarah- will they handle billing?
 - Christa- yes, The bill will say NEK Broadband, similar to Franklin Telecom. The bills go out as NEK Broadband and they will do

collections. The payments will be put into an NEK Broadband account and we will pay their invoice for their services

- Kristen- those on the Partnership Committee have a variety of backgrounds
 - Ray- background of 60 years in telecommunications, also involving fiber to the home as a vendor to verizon, testing and working with them in their lab.
 Some Satellites communications.
 - Rudy- background in management in manufacturing operations for 45 years, plant manager. During the field trip we were able to look around and see that procedures were being followed.
