Position Overview

NEKCV is seeking a highly skilled and motivated Construction Manager to oversee and coordinate broadband infrastructure projects, ensuring timely, cost-effective, and high-quality delivery. The ideal candidate will have experience in managing telecommunications or broadband construction projects, strong leadership abilities, and a comprehensive understanding of fiber optic network deployment.

Key Responsibilities

- Construction Management: Assist in the planning and scheduling and management phases of broadband buildout projects, including pre-construction. Executes project plan for construction and closeouts.
- Team Leadership: Supervise field crews, subcontractors, and construction teams to ensure work is performed safely, efficiently, and in compliance with project plans and specifications.
